## LETTER TO A FRIEND

**Ages:**

Ages 6-8

**Description:**

Trusted Adults: Students have been ONLINE! Let's take them away from the screen and connect them with friends near and far. If you have your student's friends' addresses you can help your student send a special letter to their friend!

*\*\*Note to parents/trusted adults: Please assist your student in the writing and sending of the letter.*

**Time:**

20-30 minutes

**Materials Needed:**

- Paper
- Pencils, pens, markers, or crayons
- Envelope
- Stamp (if none is available, have your student draw their own!)

**Instructions**

Step 1:

Ask your trusted adult to help you find a friend that you can connect with! You will need their address.

Step 2:

Write a letter to your friend! Ask them how they are doing, what they have been up to, what they are enjoying during this time, or send a special package (favorite snack, drawn picture/artwork. etc.)

Step 3:

Ask your trusted adult to help you write your friend's address on your envelope. See the picture below for instructions:

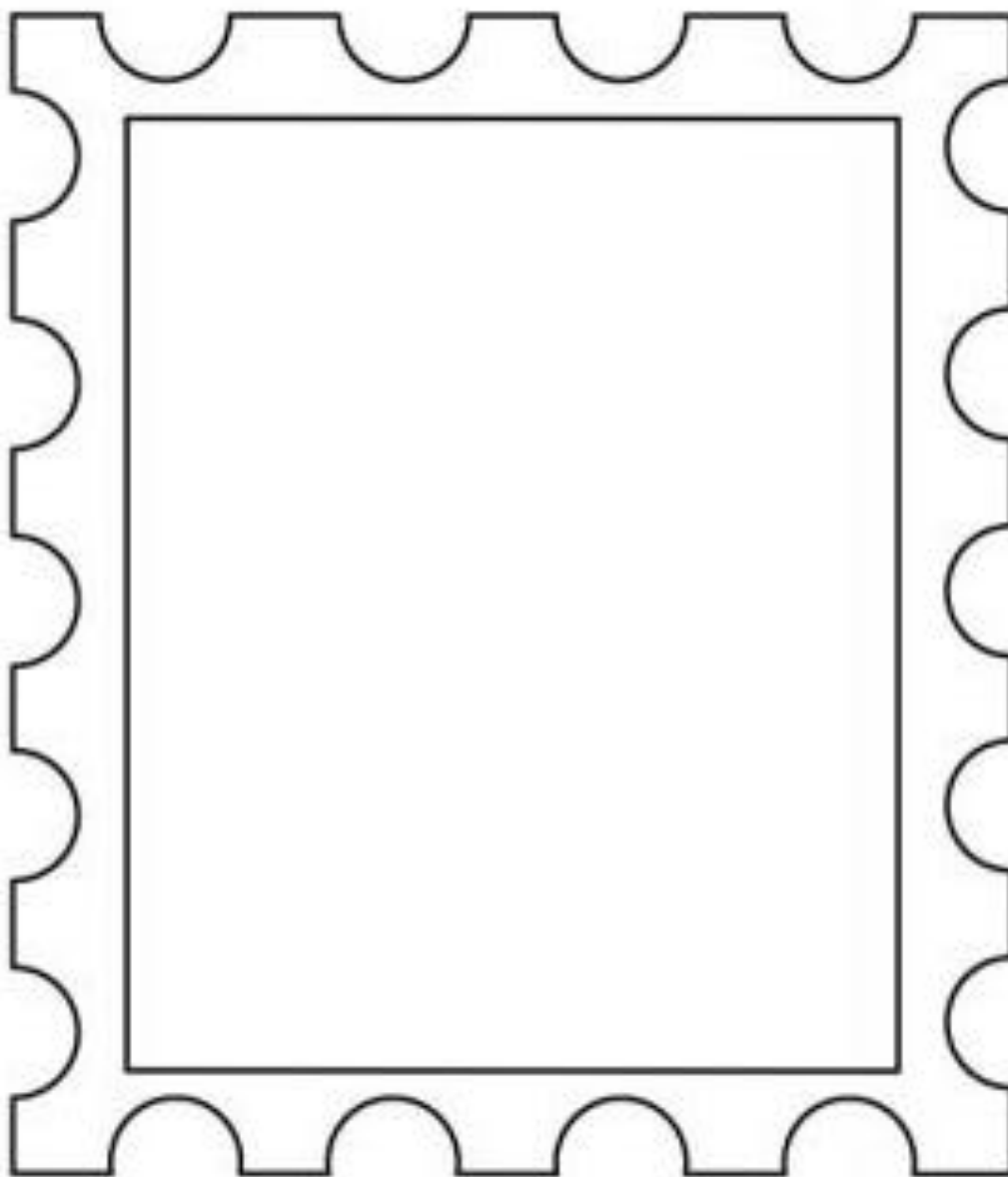
